#### 3. Facilities.

We are located in the center of Murcia, and it's very important to us that our teaching staff have the latest technological equipment so they can offer you the best of traditional teaching combined with the most advanced digital techniques and tools. Therefore, in addition to having bright, air-conditioned classrooms, all are well-equipped with interactive screens, where teachers teach both individually and in small groups.

#### 4. Included in your tuition at Alba al Español.

- The weekly class hours booked for the course.
- A textbook and any additional teaching materials needed.
- Continuous assessment.
- Certificate of completion upon completion of the course.
- Access to the platform with recorded classes, additional teaching materials, and exercises.
- Alba Spanish Library: free book lending service.
- Excursions and extracurricular activities, including museum admission for long-term courses.
- For all other courses, this fee must be paid separately.
- For other activities, such as the "traditional churros breakfast" or "tapas day," personal consumption is not included.

### II. ACADEMIC ISSUES

#### 5. Our methodology.

During classes, we practice the four language skills (oral expression and interaction, oral comprehension, written comprehension, and written expression and interaction). In addition to grammar, we also teach cultural and historical aspects of







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Spanish culture to ensure students have a better linguistic immersion in the country. But classes aren't our only focus; we also organize activities outside of class, where students can practice their communication skills in real-life situations.

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Our assessment is continuous, through various activities and tests. Furthermore, the teacher will personally monitor students' progress and record everything promptly on the online platform.

### 6. Our teachers.

To achieve your goals together and implement the school's methodology, it is essential that our teachers possess the necessary commitment, experience, empathy, and vocation, in addition to the necessary skills. Therefore, the teaching team at Alba al Español has been selected with these attitudes and aptitudes in mind.

### 8. Timetables and modalities.

Our offer is quite flexible, allowing us to adapt to your level and schedule:

Intensive courses:

4 hours per day.

Monday to Friday, 9:00 to 11:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Semi-intensive courses:

Monday to Friday, 5:00 to 7:00 p.m.

Customized courses:

2 hours per day.

### 9. Annual academic caledar.

### 10. Our online platform.

We have our own platform, whose priority is to provide you with all the necessary educational tools to maximize your academic performance. You can also follow your classes online as if you were at our center, if necessary (see the online attendance conditions in section 11). The main philosophy of our platform is "in class, but from home."

In addition, you will find:

- Access to online classes.
- All classes recorded.
- Additional teaching materials.
- Activities and exercises.
- A constantly evolving library to reserve any of the 200 titles currently available.







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- Checking absences.
- Access to a continuous assessment report and downloading a Certificate of Achievement or diploma.
- Academic calendar for the corresponding course.
- The ability to contact the academy for questions and suggestions by email, phone, and WhatsApp.
- All students will receive a short tutorial on how to use the online platform.

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### 11. Course attendance and certificate of achievement.

Your learning is our commitment, so it's important that you understand the established rules regarding class attendance:

To obtain a certificate of achievement at the end of the course, it is essential to a) obtain a **passing grade** in the modules comprising the courses and b) punctually attend at least 80 percent of all classes. Alba al Español cannot issue a certificate if these two conditions are not met.

For an intensive course (4 hours of class per day), **the grace period** for entering the classroom is 10 minutes for the first segment of the class (the first two hours of class) and 5 minutes for the second segment of the class (the following two hours). For a semiintensive course (2 hours of class per day), the grace period for entering the classroom is 10 minutes.

If you are in Spain with a student visa or residence permit, you must attend class **in person**. The online option is reserved for those who do not live in Spain, those who have not yet entered the country for legal reasons, or those who do not have a visa or residence permit. For other exceptional cases of Spanish residents who cannot attend an in-person class for a fully justified medical or legal reason, online attendance must be assessed and decided by the Head of Studies or the school's Administration.

The only way to request a justification for an absence or to request admission to an online class is with **a legally-funded** (an appointment with the immigration office to continue visa or residency procedures) or **medical certificate**. This request must be made directly to the Head of ELE Studies.

The medical certificate must meet the following requirements: a) be issued by a doctor or hospital in Spain (not in any other country); b) be signed by the doctor and stamped by the hospital; c) indicate the day and time of the doctor's visit; d) if sick leave is required, these must be indicated in writing on the certificate; e) provide the contact telephone number of the doctor and/or hospital. Furthermore, it must be submitted within one week of the visit (in person or with a photograph to <u>ele@academiaalba.es</u>).

#### 12. Library

Constantly evolving, we currently have more than 200 titles available for loan. You can search for the desired book by title, author, or category, reserve it for pickup when you come to the academy within 4 days and have it available for a period of 20 days.

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If you're missing a book, please let us know, and we'll do our best to acquire it.



### 13. Wifi

To avoid inappropriate use or disruptions to the learning process, such as distractions to other students and the teacher, and to promote interaction between students and faculty, we do not recommend the use of mobile devices except when used for educational purposes or for fully justified reasons.

For these cases, we have a powerful Wi-Fi network, and you can request the access code from the school's secretary's office (or reception) on the first day of classes.

#### 14. Extracurricular activities

At Alba al Español, we understand that learning a language goes beyond simply studying grammar. Our philosophy focuses on enriching language learning and promoting complete cultural immersion through extracurricular experiences typically offered throughout the year.

### 17. Essential places and activities in our province

In Murcia, a city with a rich history and culture, there are several must-see places and activities that we strongly recommend you do during your stay, whether or not they are included in your course:

• Route through the historic center: visit Murcia Cathedral, the Episcopal Palace, and Cardenal Belluga Square.

• Explore the Royal Casino of Murcia: one of the main tourist attractions in the heart of the city.

• Visit the Museum of Fine Arts: with galleries ranging from the Renaissance and Baroque to Romanticism. It houses works by artists such as Pedro Orrente, Joaquín Campos, and Julio Romero de Torres.

• Walk along the seafront: includes a visit to the Salzillo Museum and a boat ride on the river.

• Excursion to Monteagudo and its castle: history of King Lobo and the Moorish influence in Murcia.







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• Visit to La Fuensanta and walk through the mountains: route to the Sanctuary of the Virgin of La Fuensanta and panoramic views of Murcia.

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• Christmas market and Christmas traditions: on Paseo Alfonso X and the Nativity scene at the Cathedral.

• Enjoy the gastronomy: Try typical local dishes.

• Attend a flamenco show: Enjoy an authentic cultural experience by attending a flamenco show at one of the city's tablaos.

• Local festivals and celebrations: Participate in traditional festivals and celebrations such as Holy Week and a visit to the Museo de la Sangre (Blood Museum). Learn about the tradition of Murcia's processions.

• **Hiking**: Murcia is a fantastic place for hiking due to its beautiful natural surroundings, as long as you are well prepared for your walks, bring plenty of water and food, and keep the weather forecast in mind. The Senda Bonita (Beautiful Path) is a great way to enjoy the nature of our province.

These activities will allow you to experience Murcia's rich history, culture, nature, and beauty. The city offers a wide range of experiences for all tastes, from exploring historical monuments to relaxing in thermal baths and tasting delicious local cuisine.
